



2019 INTERNSHIP: AG DATA SPECIALIST & WAREHOUSE COORDINATOR

Overview: Mainstem is a startup craft malt company, working to connect environmentally innovative grain growers to food and beverage markets who value their conservation ethic. We are looking for an intern to split time between Mainstem's Ag Data Integration Project (ADIPOSE) and coordination of our small-but-growing warehouse. ADIPOSE intends to connect environmental and cultural ag data to our malt supply chain, with the core objectives of enhancing operational efficiencies, sustainability initiatives, and downstream experience.

Experience Requirements:

- Active student or recent graduate of an associate's or bachelor's program, with a focus in agricultural sciences or a related course of study;
- Substantial work experience in farming and/or agricultural processing, including operation of heavy machinery;
- Comfort working in both Google Suite and Microsoft Office environments;
- Past experience using spreadsheets for recordkeeping and computational purposes, ideally in a scientific setting.

Practical Requirements:

- Perform office & warehouse work from Mainstem's HQ at 1106 Dell Ave, Walla Walla;
- Provide daily personal transportation to and from 1106 Dell Ave;
- Provide occasional personal transportation to remote farms and field sites, with vehicle mileage reimbursement;
- Frequently stand, walk, and lift up to 50 pound objects, and occasionally lift up to 100 pounds, sometimes in extreme temperatures;
- Be understanding of and adaptable to a rapidly evolving startup work environment.

Responsibilities:

- *Office & Field:* Establish and maintain regular communications with Mainstem's 8 grain growers located in Washington and Oregon. Work with growers on collection of 2016-2019 ag data. Continue to build on Mainstem's existing ag database. Analyze and prepare data for communication to team and external stakeholders.
- *Warehouse:* Prepare daily outbound freight and merchandise shipments. Receive inbound shipments. Use technology to track and organize movement and storage of product. Maintain a clean and orderly warehouse environment.

Duration & Workload: Flexible summer & fall hours, up to 40 hours per week depending on the intern's availability and Mainstem's workload. Work to start as soon as June 2019.

Compensation: \$12 hourly wage.
