The mission of the Water Resources program is to support sustainable water resources management to meet present and future needs of people and the natural environment, in partnership with Washington communities.

The Environmental Technician job is a non-permanent support position to the Eastern Regional Office in the Walla Walla Field Office. Under general supervision, this position will review water rights in the Walla Walla basin, research current land ownership, contact property owners, perform site visits, and record data. They will also develop and/or populate a basic database with well-related information to support a bi-state groundwater research project performed under the auspices of the Walla Walla 2050 project.
